

Lubuntu – Additional things to test for

See document “Lubuntu refurbishing a computer”.

Packages to install.

- LibreOffice, GIMP, lubuntu-restricted-extras, lubuntu-restricted-addons, gnome-games, Google Chrome (chromium-browser).
- ruby, emacs (and package for ri command)

Tests to perform from the command line.

- Access “man” pages – “man mkdir” etc
- Access ruby documentation – ri ‘String.*’
- use emacs to edit a ruby script file – do the expected icons appear in the window, below the “File” option?
- echo “Hello World”; echo ‘Hello Ian’
- ensure you can get “, @, |, <, >, ~, #.” from the keyboard
- Test if ufw firewall is installed: sudo ufw status

Test if can print on LaserJet

- To install printer, connect it, switch it on, run Swift→Preferences→HPLIP Toolbox
- Install the HP LaserJet and print a test page
- Use the hp panel icon to see its information window

Tests to perform from the GUI

- Use LO Writer to do a “Hello, World” test page
- GIMP – can you see right hand “Layers-Brushes” window OK?
- Can you watch a DVD? sudo apt-get install libdvd-pkg
- (If you have Wi-Fi) Can you see wifi networks with Wi-Fi Radar?
- Run “System Profileer and Benchmark”. Does it work?
