LTSP® Logo Contest Official Rules

Rules & Regulations

Each artist is allowed to submit a maximum of (3) three different designs. Designs must be original and cannot infringe on existing trademarks, or logo's. Artist must submit artwork in a compressed file format to contest@disklessworkstations.com. Artist must include in his/her submission e-mail address, first and last name, mailing address, and contact phone number. The Contest begins at 8:01 AM EST January 1st, 2009, and ends at 11:59 PM EST February 27th, 2009.

Final Artwork Requirements

Include:

1. Un-flattened, layered, original format artwork (Photoshop or Gimp file)
2. Color JPEG image of original format artwork
3. Black & white image of original format artwork
4. Font information if applicable

Design Requirements

The design must include the letters L, T, S, and P.

The design should, but is not required to include wording: Linux Terminal Server Project.

The logo should be designed as a small size logo, and scalable to a larger logo without loss in quality.

The logo should have a transparent background.

Contest Prizes

First: LTSP® Term 1420 PXE + 1420 HD Mounting Kit + 1420 PCI Riser Kit (One winner)

Second: LTSP® Term 1220 PXE (One winner)

Third: Logitech® Wireless Keyboard & Mouse (One winner)

Prize Rules & Regulations

Winners are eligible to win one prize, and will be awarded the best prize available if they submit multiple designs and more than 1 design finishes in the top 3 rankings. DisklessWorkstations.com will pay for ground shipping anywhere in the continental United States. If the Contest winner is located outside of the 48-state continental United States, the winner will be required to pay for shipping charges to receive their prize. Prizes are not transferable or redeemable for cash. Prize cannot be used in conjunction with any other promotion or offer. Sponsor reserves the right to substitute prize with one of equal or greater value in the event a prize is unavailable. Acceptance of prize constitutes permission (except where prohibited) to use winner's name, hometown and likeness for purposes of advertising, promotion and publicity without additional compensation.

Voting

DisklessWorkstations.com will filter out submissions that do not meet the submission and design requirements. Accepted submissions will receive e-mail notification.

DisklessWorkstations.com will develop and publicly post a panel of voters from the LTSP community. These voters are to be voluntary participants in the Contest. Voters could be comprised of LTSP developers, and DisklessWorkstations.com's employees. Voters will have an opportunity to choose their top 3 choices (rank 1, rank 2, rank 3) out of every submission. Artwork that receives a

1st rank vote receives 3 points. Artwork that receives a 2nd rank vote receives 2 points. Artwork that receives a 3rd rank vote receives 1 point. Total points for every valid submission will be calculated, the submission with the most points will be deemed the 1st place winner. To have your artwork voted on, you must follow the rules and regulations throughout this document. Voting will take place between March 1st, 2009 – March 15th, 2009. Winners will be announced no later than March 31st, 2009.
