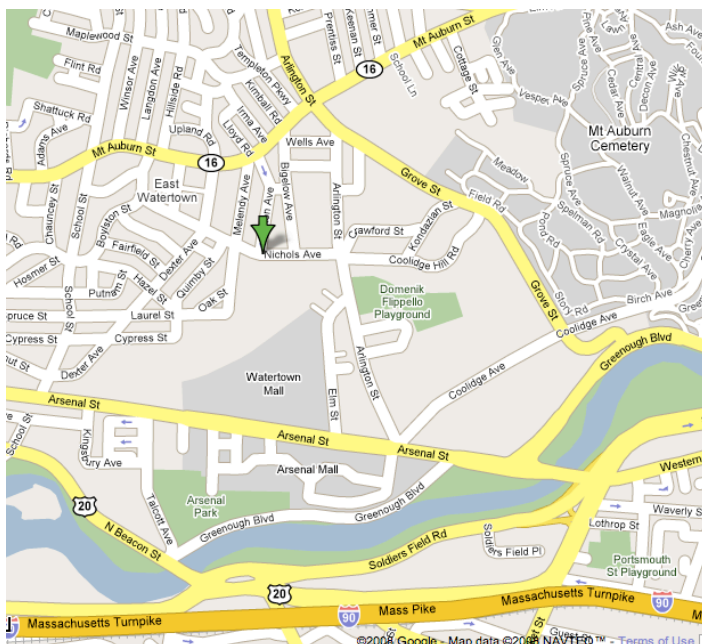

Directions

From Route 128: Take **Exit 25** onto the **Mass Pike** (I-90) in the direction of Boston. Proceed Eastbound on the Pike for 4.9 miles, and then take **Exit 17** (Newton Corner). Go ¼ way around the Newton Corner rotary and over the Pike, and then continue straight onto **Galen Street**. Proceed for ½ mile until you get to Watertown Square, and continue straight through the big intersection onto **Mount Auburn Street**. Go 1.5 miles until you see the Deluxe Diner, and

turn right onto **Bigelow Street**. Proceed for 2 blocks and turn right onto **Nichols Avenue**. You can park on the street or in the parking lot across from **Elton Avenue**.



From Storrow Drive: Traveling West on Storrow, after you pass Harvard Stadium on your left, continue straight over the **Eliot Bridge**, and then bear left at the next traffic light onto **Greenough Boulevard**. At the next traffic light, turn right onto **Arsenal Street**. At the next light (next to Aegean Restaurant), turn 45 degrees right onto **Arlington Street**. Go 2 blocks and then turn left onto **Nichols Avenue**.
