General Meeting:

Team Leader

Offline Codecs Project

- Team Leader Donald indicated that he is a position to organize hardware for testing with Microman

- He indicated that there is plenty of interest in Linux training locally
- Donald proposed that we come up with a rotating training model where the trainer, Phoenix Technologies (for the hardware) and the LoCo team would share the training income
